Subject: Communication to Shareholders for TDS deduction

We are pleased to inform you that the Board of Directors at their Meeting held on 30th July, 2020 has recommended a Dividend of Rs. 25/- per Equity Share of Rs.10/- each (250%) for the Financial Year ended 31st March, 2020 and the said Dividend will be payable post approval of the shareholders at the ensuing Annual General Meeting ("AGM") of the Company.

As you are aware that as per the Income Tax Act, 1961, as amended by the Finance Act, 2020, dividends paid or distributed by a Company on or after 1st April, 2020 shall be taxable in the hands of the shareholders. The Company shall therefore be required to deduct tax at source at the time of making the payment of the said Dividend, if declared at the above AGM.

The TDS rate may vary depending on the residential status of the shareholder and the documents submitted to the Company in accordance with the provisions of the Act. However, in case of individuals, TDS would not apply if the aggregate of total dividend distributed to them by the Company during financial year 2020-21 does not exceeds Rs.5,000/-. Shareholders will also be able to see the credit of TDS in Form 26AS, which can be downloaded from their e-filing account at https://incometaxindiaefiling.gov.in.

It may be further noted that in case the tax on the Dividend, is deducted at a higher rate in absence of receipt of the aforementioned details/documents from you, shareholder have an option to file the return of income and claim an appropriate refund, if eligible.
